In 2021, this facility conducted three investigations into alleged PREA incidents. In summary, we had zero (0) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate non-consensual sexual acts. We had zero (0) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate abusive sexual contact. We had zero (0) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment. We investigated three (3) alleged incidents of staff sexual misconduct. Two (2) of the incidents were unsubstantiated and one (1) was unfounded. We had zero alleged incidents of staff sexual harassment.

In 2022, this facility conducted one investigation into alleged PREA incidents. In summary, we had zero (0) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate non-consensual sexual acts. We had zero (0) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate abusive sexual contact. We had zero (0) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment. We had one (1) alleged incident of staff sexual misconduct which was unsubstantiated. We had zero (0) allegations of staff sexual harassment.

In 2023, this facility conducted 5 investigations into alleged PREA incidents. In summary, we had zero (0) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate non-consensual sexual acts. We had zero (0) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment. We had one (1) alleged incident of inmate on inmate abusive sexual contact. This allegation was unfounded. We investigated four (4) alleged incidents of staff sexual misconduct. Two (2) of the incidents were unfounded, one (1) was unsubstantiated, one (1) was substantiated. We had one (1) alleged incidents of staff sexual harassment. This allegation was substantiated.

No recommendations are being made at this time in the area of policy changes, none of the incidents appeared to be motivated by race; ethnicity; or gender identity, staffing

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levels appear to be adequate for the size of the facility, and the camera system continues to play a vital part in the facilities capabilities toward detection and deterrence of PREA incidents. Training for all employees, contractors, volunteers and inmates concerning PREA are on-going.
